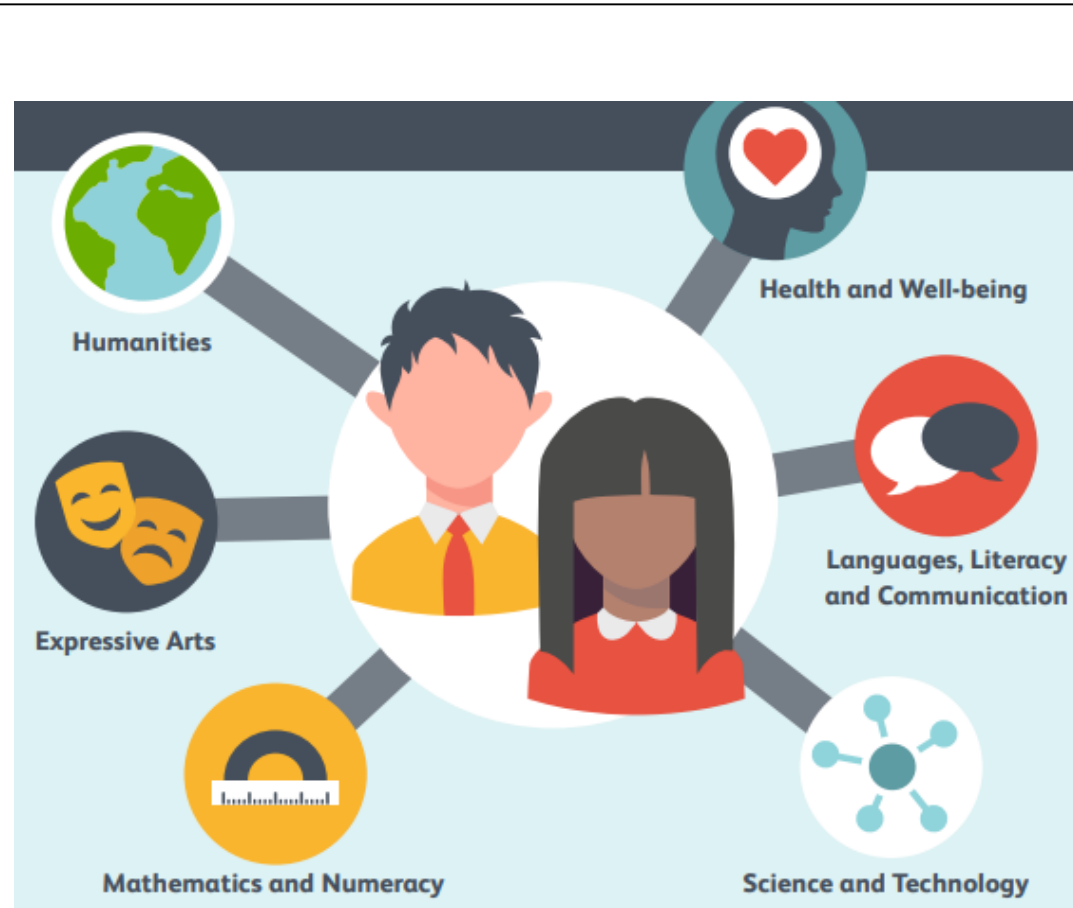
Ein Cwricwlwm / Our Curriculum

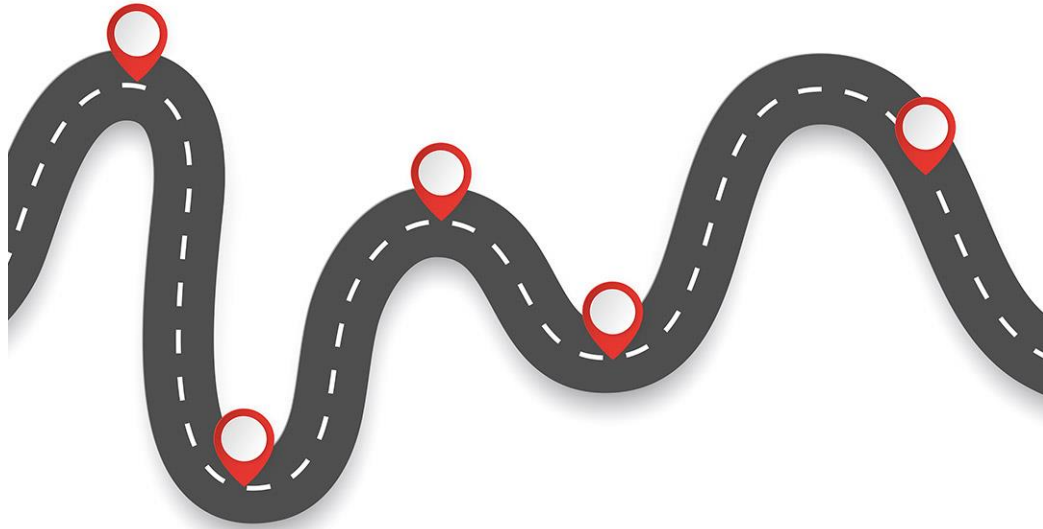


In addition to the areas of learning, the curriculum focuses on a child's:

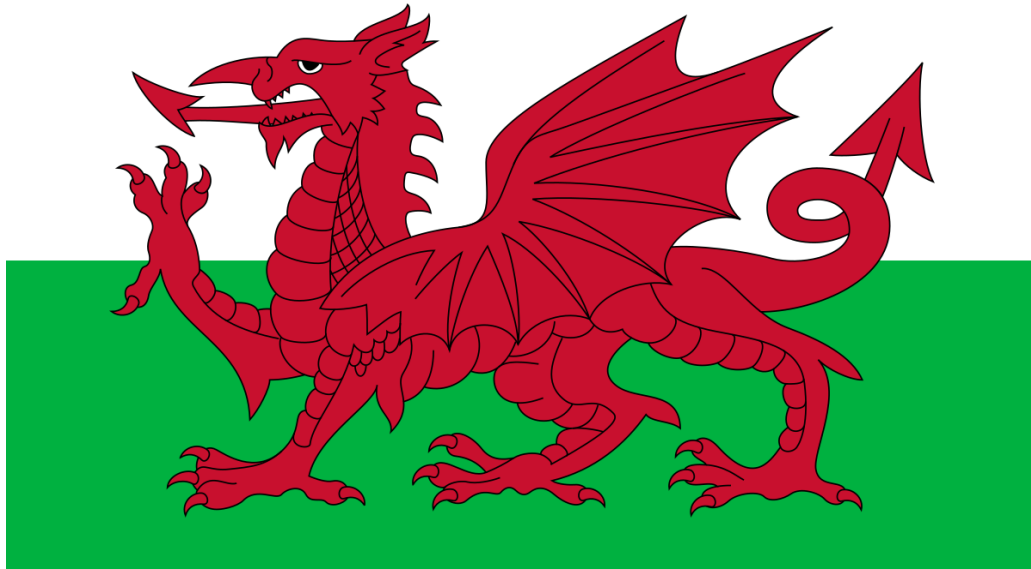


Will also develop integral skills:

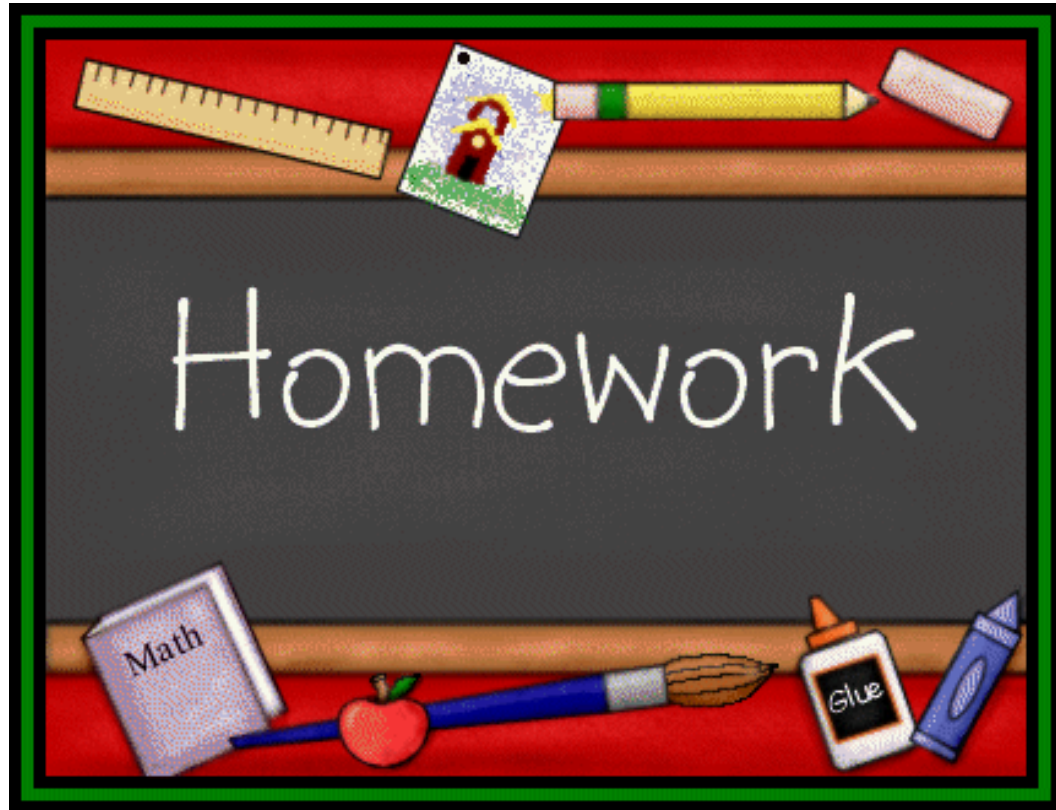
